What project reviews can you provide?

A **project commencement** review is an ideal time to bring together the new project team with members of previous teams that have experience to share.

Best practice methods can be drawn out and used. It is the point in a project when correcting mistakes is the least expensive.

Reviews like this are effective in building a consistent approach to learning from lessons and ensuring that previous mistakes are omitted from the new project from the start.

Regular, shorter **reviews throughout the project** can be used to capture experience and lessons after any significant event.

We recommend that they take place to a specified timescale or when things are not looking as 'on track' as they should be.

They ensure that corrective or supporting actions can be implemented immediately, reducing over-runs and escalating costs.

The purpose of the **post project review** is to take a fresh look at the completed project. We will focus on finding lessons and outputs that went well and areas to improve upon for future projects.

The aim of this review is to promote collaboration and agreement on what and why there were advantages and disadvantages to doing things a certain way. We also ensure that all lessons result in an action to enhance ongoing performance.
